## We Built Stronger Networks in Support of Family Caregivers



- Launched Caregiver Nation Network, connecting grassroots care champions across 10 states for peer-led learning and advocacy.
- Hosted our 2nd annual Caregiver Nation Summit, convening 600+ leaders from across the aging, disability, and patient advocacy communities to shape the future of caregiving.
- Convened 500+ medical experts, family caregivers, and patient advocates through 10+ educational events focused on improving serious illness caregiving.
- Launched the Creating and Advancing Caregiving Research and Evidence (CARE) Network with support from the Administration for Community Living.

## We Shaped Federal Policy to Value Family Caregivers



- Secured Medicare reforms strengthening access to caregiver training services and expanding coverage for complex care training.
- Organized 120+ congressional meetings that helped drive Senate passage of the Older Americans Act Reauthorization Act, a program that supports millions of older adults and their family caregivers.
- Advanced implementation of the National Strategy to Support Family Caregivers by securing \$2M for state programs and detailed federal action reporting.
- Championed bipartisan congressional resolutions recognizing National Family Caregivers Month and key policies.
- Provided technical assistance shaping more than 30 pieces of federal legislation impacting caregiver supports and services.

## We Delivered Credible Research to Drive Action



- Our research and experts informed 4,000+ media stories on family caregiving, reaching more than 23 million people.
- More than 500 peer-reviewed publications built on NAC's research to better understand the challenges caregivers face and find solutions that work.
- Released 4 new reports and briefs on critical issues shaping care policy and practice, including a new research report on transplant caregiving.
