Jason Resendez is a nationally recognized **family policy expert and advocate** dedicated to transforming how America values care. As **President and CEO of the National Alliance for Caregiving (NAC)**, he is at the forefront of driving research, policy, and systems change initiatives that impact the more than **63 million family caregivers** across the country.

Prior to leading NAC, Jason was the founding executive director of the **UsAgainstAlzheimer's Center for Brain Health Equity**. There, he **pioneered the concept of Brain Health Equity** through peer-reviewed research, public health partnerships, and public policy, challenging the status quo in brain health. In 2023, STAT News named Jason one of the most consequential leaders in health and medicine.

He has advised federal agencies and organizations working to improve the health and wellness of American families — including the National Institute on Aging, the National Academies of Medicine, the Administration for Community Living, and the Congressional Hispanic Caucus Institute—and served as a volunteer policy advisor for President Joe Biden's presidential campaign.

His leadership has earned widespread recognition. In 2023, STAT News named Jason one of the most consequential leaders in health and medicine, and PBS's Next Avenue listed him among America's top influencers in aging, alongside figures like Michael J. Before leading NAC, Jason was the founding executive director of the UsAgainstAlzheimer's Center for Brain Health Equity, where he pioneered the concept of brain health equity through peer-reviewed research, public health partnerships, and public policy. Earlier in his career, he worked at UnidosUS and the education arm of the League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC), two of the nation's leading civil rights organizations.
